Introduction

As I present our second annual Prohire Group ESG report, I am extremely proud to share that, since the publication of our first ESG report in July 2023, we have achieved the internationally recognised environmental management standard, ISO 14001.

Achieving this standard, a key objective of our ESG strategy, ensures that Prohire meets environmental regulations by improving efficiency whilst demonstrating our ongoing commitment to improving our environmental performance. It recognises the increased prominence of environmental management within Prohire's strategic planning processes, greater input from leadership and a stronger commitment to proactive initiatives that boost environmental performance, all of which were outlined in our first ESG report.



The accreditation provides a framework for a systematic and integrated approach for all employees, which allows the environmental management system to become part of the fabric of our business. Through the implementation of this standard, we are already seeing increased employee engagement that aligns with our ongoing ESG plans.

Our alternative fuels division, ProGreen continues to support our customers in achieving their Net Zero ambitions by decarbonising fleets via the deployment of high-performing, reliable, zero-emission vehicle technology. By the end of March 2024, 26 percent of Prohire's new vehicles will feature an alternative technology.

Our strength lies in our team, and we continue to invest in local people, systems and sustainable infrastructure. We're a proud employer and our commitment to finding and training new talent locally, particularly for highly skilled technical roles, continues. In November 2023, we expanded our operations in the south and into London by unveiling a new workshop at our depot in Tunbridge Wells. As a result, we recruited eight new colleagues, tripling the size of our team at Prohire South. We've invested in the wellbeing of our team as well as continuing our focus on mental health.

We have the best team in the industry, and I look forward to working with them in 2024 and beyond to deliver our ESG strategy.


